Grade	Point Equivalent

- Students need a total of 10 points to pass
 - A=10 points
 - B=7.5 points
 - C=5 points
 - D=2.5 points
 - F=0 points
- Students who are enrolled in High School courses must earn 5 of those points during the second semester
- Students can fail up to two courses and still be promoted to the next grade level, however they will have to retake the core classes during the summer
- If students do not earn at least 10 points in three or more courses, they will be retained

Passing Grades



Magnet Schools: Application Process




Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) are accepting applications for Magnet Programs starting the first week of October until mid January. Here are the most important things you need to know about the application process:

- 1. The fastest way to apply is online at www.dadeschools.net via the Parent Portal by clicking on the magnet application link. Online applications are processed instantly into the application system.**
- 2. Students can apply for a spot at up to five programs at five different schools. You cannot select more than one program in a single school.**



Magnet Schools: Application Process



3. To be eligible for a magnet program, **students must have a 2.0 (C AVERAGE) Grade Point Average (GPA) in core academic areas.** Some programs, such as International Baccalaureate, require a 2.5 GPA.

4. Individual schools have different requirements, such as recommendations, specific subjects students must have completed prior to applying, auditions, interviews, or minimum grades. You must contact the school as soon as you apply to request each school's requirements.

Scholarships for Private Schools

1. K-12 students regardless of household income, who are residents of Florida and eligible to enroll in a K-12 public school, can receive a scholarship worth an average of \$7,800 to attend a private school that best meets their academic needs.
2. The scholarship can be used for tuition along with other related expenses such as registration, books, testing, and other fees.


1. **OPEN HOUSE: October 14th**

3. Entrance Exam (*Incoming 9th Graders Only*): After the online application is submitted, you will get access to register for the entrance exam. The Entrance Exam fee is \$50. **ENTRANCE EXAM IS ON DECEMBER 2ND**
4. Copy of Birth Certificate.
5. Parent/Student Interview with Admissions Committee.
6. **7th Grade Final Report Card.**
7. **Current Grades from 8th Grade.**
8. Standardized Testing Results (**FAST PM 3 Results**)
9. (If Applicable) Psycho-Educational Evaluation dated within the last 3 years.
10. (If Applicable) Individualized Education Plan (IEP) / 504 Plan/ Physician's Statement
